- Bryn provided a powerpoint presentation on our upcoming referendum to be voted on April $2^{\text {nd }}$
- The overview:
- Turn Cardinal Heights Upper Middle School into a $6^{\text {th }}-8^{\text {th }}$ grade middle school, Patrick Marsh and Prairie View will also be $6^{\text {th }}-8^{\text {th }}$
- Build a $2^{\text {nd }}$ high school on the West side of Sun Prairie
- Replace aging Prairie Phoenix Academy, combining those students in the Cardinal Heights building
- Updating Ashley Field in place of the old PPA building
- Additional Comments:
- Our projected enrollment is $\$ 4,492$ students by the 2020-2021 school year
- We are currently the largest high school in the state, and currently over target capacity

- If the referendum passes, the $2^{\text {nd }}$ high school and 3 middle schools would begin in Fall of 2021.
- There will be an Open House on Wednesday, March $13^{\text {th }}$
- Some questions were asked by the parents and Bryn answered. Some concerns included: walking traffic to Cardinal Heights bringing possible trespassing into residential yards. Why Prairie Phoenix Academy wants to be a part of the middle school instead of high school (because the Principal preferred to be a part of Cardinal Heights building and there are already tech rooms available), some concern about the groups who are against the referendum being reached and met with to understand everything (Brad Saron, superintendent, is meeting with these various groups)
