SNOW DAY UPDATE- CHANGE TO SCHOOL TIMES

AS A REMINDER:

For **4K AM classes, four minutes will be added to the beginning of class, and two minutes will be added at the end of class**. The new 4K AM times will be as follows:

Elementary School Sites - 7:36 to 10:25 am

Bus pickup times will remain the same for students at Creekside, Northside and Token Springs.

Community Partner Sites - 7:46 to 10:35 am

Bus pickup times will be 5 minutes earlier for all other 4K locations.

For **4K PM classes, four minutes will be added at the beginning of class.** The new 4K PM times will be as follows:

Elementary School Sites - 11:35 to 2:40 pm (Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, Friday) 11:35 to 1:30 pm (Thursday)

Community Partner Sites - 11:25 to 2:30 pm (Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, Friday) 11:25 to 1:20 pm (Thursday)

Bus pickup times will be 5 minutes earlier for all 4K locations.



TIME TO REGISTER FOR K2K SUMMER SCHOOL

Greetings Parents/Caregivers of Students who will be entering Kindergarten!

We look forward to welcoming your children to Summer School. We are excited to share information on the upcoming Summer School 2023 program. This is a great time for your children to learn more about how to succeed in elementary school classes. I am including information on the various parts of Summer School that I hope are helpful in preparing your child and you.

We offer one class, *Kickoff to Kindergarten (K2K)*, for students who will be entering Kindergarten in the fall. You can register your incoming Kindergarten child for the five week class, **June 20 to July 20 2023**. The class will be held from 8:05 am - 12:50 pm, Monday through Thursday every week.

If your child receives special education services, please work with the Early Childhood Special Education teacher to determine if K2K would be a good fit. Special Education services during summer school are not provided at the same level as during the regular school year. I hope the information is clear, easy to understand, and helpful. I am sending the complete packet at this time and then over the upcoming weeks, I'll send components as reminders. Please watch for the information in your email. The Infinite Campus portal will open for Summer School requests to be submitted on March 14, 2023 at 8 am.

Summer School staff should be highly visible to your children and you. Staff members will wear bright **PINK** bandanas and there will be **PINK** signs for the class during the first weeks of Summer School.

SCHOOL CLOSING- DUE TO WEATHER

SCHOOL CANCELATIONS:

If it becomes necessary to call off school because of poor weather conditions or other reasons, an announcement will be made before 6:30 a.m. on the district website, sunprairieschools.org, and on local radio and television stations.

If poor weather or any other building problems cause the school to be closed, a taped message will be left on the school closing information line, 834-6688, Ext. 2561. Families will also be notified through the "Blackboard Mass Notifications" system. Phone calls, emails, and text messages will be sent directly to parents/ or legal guardians at the time the decision is made. Please do not call the SP4K site or the bus company.

DELAYED START:

When the start of the school day is delayed for 1-2 hours, there will be no morning session of SP4K. It is important that students enrolled in the afternoon session do not arrive at school until the stated starting time.

WINTER GUIDANCE: PLAYING OUTSIDE

WEATHER RULES

SP4K programs provide outdoor playtime to give students the opportunity to practice motor and social skills. All students are expected to participate in outdoor playtime, so please send appropriate gear every day. It's important that caregivers assist their children with dressing appropriately for the day's weather.

If a student needs to remain indoors when coming back to school after an illness or injury, please provide written verification from your child's health care provider.

Students will stay indoors during inclement weather or when the air or wind chill temperature is at or below 0°F.

IF YOU HAVE MOVED DURING THE SCHOOL YEAR

- As a 4K student, your child has automatically been enrolled in kindergarten at your assigned elementary school.
- Please make sure that the 4K office has your new address! Your kindergarten enrollment is based on the address we currently have on file for 4K.
- In January you will start getting information from your elementary school about kindergarten.

KOBUSSEN BUS-

- · Buses can be noisy places. Please help your child remember to use their "0-1"voices, so the drivers can be safe. Sometimes, when bus drivers have to speak loudly to be heard, our kiddos mistake loud for "yelling". We have given the bus drivers this tool to help our 4K students understand what kind of voice they should be using on the bus. It is also used in our classrooms so your children should be familiar with the tool and the language used.
- · Stayingseated in their seats is very important. Even if the ride is short please help us to reinforce the need to stay sitting in their seats, until the teacher comes to get them off the bus.
- · Please be prepared to meet your child's bus 10-15 minutes before the scheduled bus times you have been given. Due to absences and our door to door busing the bus times may vary within that time frame.
- · If your child is not going to be riding the bus to or from school please let the bus company AND your teacher know.

 We want to make sure we know exactly who is getting on and

off the bus every day. <u>The bus company can be reached at 825-</u>8700.
