### Developed Criteria

#### We will be asking these questions:

- Does it adhere to board policy?
- Will it endure time without controversy?
- Can it be confused with other regional school names?
- Is it aligned with the mission and vision?
- Does it avoid political controversy?
- Check the name in other languages does it translate OK?
- Is it offensive in any way?
- Is it easily pronounced by English Language Learners?
- Is the Acronym appropriate?
- Does it represent the geographical area that it is being built as well as topography?

#### We will not be considering any of the following:

- Duplicate mascots/names that already exist in the district
- Names of living individuals
- Cardinal as another mascot
- Native American mascots or symbols






#### Community Involvement

- Students, staff, and the entire community was involved in the naming process
- A survey was developed to collect the input of all community members willing to share their ideas







#### Community Involvement | Community Naming Survey

- The community wide survey was made available online and in a paper format August 14, 2019 and closed on August 30, 2019
- 1,000+ surveys were submitted






#### Community Survey Results

- The committee vetted the 1,000+ survey results using the criteria, and then narrowed the options further down to:
  - Two names for both the Current and Second High School Names
  - Three names for the 3rd Middle School
  - Three mascot options for the 3rd Middle School
  - Three mascot options for the 2nd High School
- These options were included in a survey to our 6th-12th grade students and all Sun Prairie Area School District staff



### Student and Staff Input | 6th-12th Grade Student & Staff Survey #1


- The student and staff survey was sent out on September 24, 2019 and closed on October 7, 2019.
- 1,988 Surveys were submitted | 460 Staff & 1,458 Students





#### Student and Staff Input | 6th-12th Grade Student & Staff Survey #2

- Results for the second high school mascot were too close
- Committee removed last choice and advanced top two mascot options
- A second student and staff survey was sent out on October 20, 2019 and closed at midnight on October 23, 2019.
- 2,101 Surveys were submitted | 647 Staff & 1,454 Students




