

Governance Model Background


The Sun Prairie Area School Board has adopted the "Coherent Governance" model as a framework to clarify their roles and responsibilities, empowering and enabling them to govern well. The model includes Student Results Policies, Operational Expectations, Governance Culture Policies, and Board-Superintendent Relationship Policies to guide them in their role as Board members.

The Board's job is to represent, lead, and serve the citizens and to govern the district by establishing expectations for student achievement results, expectations for quality operational performance, and monitoring actual performance against those expectations.

GOVERNANCE CULTURE

The Board will govern lawfully and ethically with primary focus on:

- Setting the vision and direction rather than internal preoccupation
- Strategic leadership more than management detail
- Future rather than past or present
- Clear distinction of Board and Superintendent roles
- Encouraging all voices be heard, especially the community whom we serve and represent
- Building trusting and respectful relationships
- And most importantly student achievement



Board Purpose: The Sun Prairie Area School District Board of Education is the governing Board of the Sun Prairie Area School District. The Board leads, directs, and supervises the affairs of the District through policy development and accountability. The Board serves, and is accountable to, the community primarily by ensuring the district achieves the results described in the Board's Student Achievement Results Policies and that it operates according to the values expressed in the Board's Operational Expectations Policies.

Board/Superintendent Relations: The Board and superintendent will work together as colleagues as documented in policy to achieve the Student Results.

Community Linkages: These sessions are hosted by the Board to gather information and understanding of what the community's values are for the students and the district. They are candid, open conversations.

Monitoring Reports: Each report is an indepth examination of Student Result Policies and Operational Expectation Policies to ensure district accountability.





The Sun Prairie Area School District Board of Education is made up of seven elected community members to serve three-year terms. The Board appoints two non-voting student members that each serve a one-year term. All School Board elections are nonpartisan and held in April. The superintendent is appointed by the Board.
