Financial Report: Leanne Wege

- The majority of the money in the Hootie Hustle line is from sponsorships, rather than from parent donations. Those donations will hit the financial report next month.

New Box Tops App: Tara Dobberfuhl

- Tara showed how easy it is to use the new Box Tops app. We've earned \$62.10 so far through the app. When you set up your account, you can choose your school, it's easiest to search by zipcode. You can also see how your box tops have been earned.
- You have 14 days after purchasing to scan your receipt to get credit.
- You can definitely still clip box tops from products, but you can also scan your receipts to get double credit.
- At the bottom, you can choose the star that says give credit, and then type in your child's teacher's name.
- The app gives specific directions on how to upload the receipt. It's very easy.
- On the homepages of the app, it will tell you the special deals for the week. Sometimes you can get bonus box tops for specific products.
- Some products like Reynolds, Ziploc, Scotch, etc, are only clip-only box tops, so do not be distressed if scanning a receipt with those items doesn't result in a box tops credit.
- If a product doesn't get credited, you can report missing credits through the app.
